Every student in his class would say the same thing. She holds a special place in their hearts because of the special bond she has built with them. She instills a loving confidence by believing in each one of them. She guides them in faith and has truly brought each student closer to God. She makes each child feel like they are unique and special to her. They know that to this day, they can always go to her when they are in need of support.

...St. Mother Theodora Guerin said it best, "Love the children first, then teach them." When I reflect on the manner in which our nominee leads a group of Middle School students through a Theology lesson or the peaceful and nurturing manner in which she advises a young person towards righteousness, I keep coming back to St. Mother Theodora Guerin's quote.
