Dear St. Barnabas School Families,

It is hard to believe that it is time to register for the 2021-2022 school year. Thank you for choosing St. Barnabas School for your child's education! We are grateful for the support of our parents and our parish for allowing the mission of St. Barnabas School to be lived every day. I am reminded of the words of our founding pastor, Fr. Sciarra who said, "As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace." It is only through the generous giving of all that we are able to continue to operate as a ministry of the parish supported mainly through stewardship.

Families are asked to support our stewardship message which includes:

- Regular Mass attendance and faithful and consistent stewardship of time, talent, and treasure (financial support) to the parish by Catholic families of students attending or wishing to attend the School.
- Tithing should target 5% of gross income.
- Current pledge card completed, and tithing pledge fulfilled.
- School families will sign the tuition and participating parishioner fee payment policy which acts as a binding contract between family and parish. (Participating parishioners are those who have shown a year's history of faithful mass attendance and giving as members of the Parish as determined by our Business Office.)
- Both participating and non-participating parishioner School families are required to attend mandatory school meetings as they are scheduled.

Fees and tuition for the 2021-2022 and the registration process for 2021-2022 are as follows:

School Fees 2021-2022 – Participating Parishioner Rate

Grades K-5, 7-8 \$1,480

Grade 6 \$1,780 (and new 6-8th grade students - includes a one-time \$300 fee per student for the purchase of a School Secured Chrome Book)

Tuition 2021-2022 – Non-Participating and/or Non-parishioners

Grades K-8 (\$300 additional fee for each child in grade 6 and new 6-8th grade students for the purchase of a School Secured Chrome Book.)

Three Children	\$14,100	Six Children	\$21,900

Pre-Kindergarten for All Families

Monday-Friday Option, full week, all day \$5,000

Registration

Registration is open to current school families only beginning Monday, February 8th. We will open registration up to the public beginning Monday, February 22nd. Registration is \$250 per child and is deducted from your school fees/tuition amount. The \$250 per child fee **MUST** be submitted with ALL registrations to be eligible for consideration for admission. **(Any reimbursements due to CHOICE scholarships will be available after January 15, 2022).** Families must be up to date on all financial obligations at the school in order to receive their registration packet for next year. I have included an “Admissions and Registration” FAQ with this letter to answer any questions you may have. Please read our “Admission” & “Tuition and Participating Parishioner Fee” Policies. Then, please complete and return your registration fee, the 2021-2022 School Registration, Admission & Tuition Policy documents, and an emergency card for your family.

We have so much to be thankful for as we prepare for the next school year. Planning is well underway as we strive to fulfill our mission to help all students grow in mind, heart, and spirit to become leaders in the world. As we begin registration, we welcome new families, and I encourage you to share the good news of St. Barnabas School with others.
