Congratulations to our charter National Honor Society Members!

Did you know that NJHS was founded in 1929 by the National Association of Secondary School Principals, and it is one of our nation's oldest and largest recognition programs? NJHS focuses on the pillars of scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship. During the summer of 2017, it became a goal to create a St. Barnabas Catholic School Chapter of NJHS. A St. Barnabas Faculty Council met with our Chapter Adviser, Mrs. Lisa Lozano to determine how we would begin. It was determined that students in grades 6, 7, 8 who achieved high honor roll for three consecutive quarters would be considered for induction for our charter year. Students meeting this academic criteria were then asked to complete a thorough application demonstrating a heart for service, leadership, and good citizenship. These students will then meet with Mrs. Lozano throughout the 2018-2019 school year as members of the National Junior Honor Society. Congratulations to these individuals!

## **NJHS FAQ:**

### **What is NJHS?**

The National Junior Honor Society is an organization established to recognize outstanding middle level students. More than just an honor roll, NJHS serves to honor those students who have demonstrated excellence in the areas of scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship. These characteristics have been associated with membership in the organization since its beginning in 1929.

Today, it is estimated that more than one million students participate in official Honor Society activities. NHS and NJHS chapters are found in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, many U.S. territories, and Canada. Chapter membership not only recognizes students for their accomplishments, but challenges them to develop further through active involvement in school activities and community service.

### **How do I qualify for membership next year?**

St. Barnabas middle school students (grades 6, 7, 8) who have achieved High Honor Roll status for the first three grading periods of the current school year are eligible to apply for membership. Students must also submit a Candidate Information Form by the deadline in the Spring, make sure all required service hours for religion are up-to-date, and receive positive recommendations for the middle school faculty. Students must also attend the chapter induction ceremony.

### **What are my obligations as a member?**

- Maintain High Honor Roll status every grading period after induction.
- Complete all service hours as required in religion class.
- Maintain good citizenship as evidenced by no detentions and no in-school suspensions or other serious disciplinary action.
- Maintain good character as demonstrated by a positive social media presence.
- Attend meetings regularly.
- Participate in group service project.




